21. Double entries are permitted, subject to the following restrictions:
- (a) A driver may enter no more than two cars, and if he does so, they must be in different classes.
 - (b) No more than two drivers may enter in any one car.
 - (c) No car may be entered in more than one class.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Machars Car Club Ltd., will organise a National 'B' Permit Sprint on Sunday, 6th May, 2018 at Kames Motorsport Complex, Muirkirk, Ayrshire. (MR.71/695264).
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd., (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A.) these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. M.S.A. Permit No. 107300, has been issued for this year's event.
4. The event is open to all fully-elected members of Scottish car clubs affiliated to the M.S.A.
5. All drivers must produce a valid competition licence and club membership card.
6. The event is a round of the following championships:- The 2018 Scottish Sprint Championship; The 2018 Scottish Speed Championship; and The 2018 Lowland Speed Championship.
7. The programme of the meeting will be: Scrutineering starts at 9.00 a.m.; Any competitor not signed on by 10.30 a.m. may be excluded; Practising starts at 10.30 a.m.; First timed run starts at 1.30 p.m.
8. The length of the course is 3 laps of approximately 800 yards each, run in an anticlockwise direction.
9. The event will consist of the following classes:

13. The maximum entry for the meeting, including reserves, is 100. The minimum is 30. There is no maximum per class. The minimum per class is 4. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.
Entries will be selected with preference being given to drivers registered for the championships. Entry fees may be refunded if withdrawal is notified prior to the closing date.
14. Other officials are: M.S.A. Steward - to be advised; Club Stewards - to be advised.

15. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event.
16. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with regulation C5.
17. The starting order will be determined by practice times. Cars will start at 10 second intervals, with two on the track at one time. The starting signal will be a green light, and the timing by electronic timing equipment. The finish will be indicated by a line on the track and a chequered flag.
18. Competitors will be allowed two practice runs consisting of 3 laps each.
