



# Scottish Sporting Car Club

## **Final Instructions: Iain Pinkerton Memorial Sprint, Kames, Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2024**

Thank you for your entry. Please note the following:

1. This meeting is organised by The Scottish Sporting Car Club Ltd and will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsports UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA). These Final Instructions form part of the Supplementary Regulations and should be read in conjunction with them and any further instructions or bulletins issued by the clubs.

3. Kames Motorsport Complex is situated just off the A70 in Muirkirk, East Ayrshire. It is 13 miles west of J12 on the M74 and 10 miles east of Cumnock. The full address is: **Kames Motorsport Complex, Furnace Rd, Muirkirk, East Ayrshire, KA18 3QQ**

4. The paddock will be open from 3:00pm on Friday afternoon and 07:00 on Saturday and Sunday mornings.

5. On arrival at Kames, please use the top entrance (the gate farthest away along the access road to the circuit). **Please remember that residents of Muirkirk live directly opposite the circuit, so please keep noise to a minimum (particularly early in the morning or later in the evening).**

6. If you are using a trailer, please unload your car in the lower paddock and promptly remove your trailer to the trailer park. Park your trailer around the perimeter of the trailer park and try to avoid blocking others in or stopping them from using valuable space. If you arrive after the start of practice please use the lower (first) entry gate and off-load your car in the trailer park as the lower paddock will be in use by then.

7. The clubhouse café will be open throughout the event from Saturday morning and will also be putting on a dinner on the Saturday night. At the last Kames Sprint over 30 competitors and officials enjoyed a great night with excellent food and company, some reckon it's the best evening event in Scottish (and possibly all of UK) Motorsport! Dinner must be pre-booked, make sure you don't miss out and book as soon as possible via the following link:

8. Your competition number and paddock bay are detailed in the *Combined Entry List for 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> May and Kames Paddock Plan* which can be found on the Notice Board. All drivers have the same competition number and paddock space on both Saturday and Sunday. The paddock will be busy, so although we have done our best within the constraints of the area available, it may not be possible to park a support vehicle beside your competing car in every case. Should space become limited you may be asked to move your support vehicle and we would ask for your cooperation if this becomes necessary.

9. The timetable for the meeting is

10. Signing-on will be in the Race Control Cabin at the track end of the top paddock. Your MsUK Competition licence and a valid club membership card **MUST** be shown. Please endeavour to sign on prior to scrutineering. NOTE: Kames' stock of competition numbers is now exhausted – please make sure to bring numbers with you.

11. Scrutineering will be *in situ*, in your position in the paddock. All competitors must have their scrutineering pass fixed to their car and visible to the paddock marshal before being permitted to start their run. Your attention is drawn to MSA Regulation S.9.2.1 regarding the wearing of crash helmets and clean fire-resistant overalls, gloves and FHR device (where required), all of which items must be presented for inspection at Scrutineering. On-board cameras must be present and mounted on the car before being scrutineered. Mounting must comply with J5.21.5

**If required by the scrutineer, competitors in Division S1, A and D1, must produce hard copies of the MOT (if applicable) together with the accompanying emissions certificate, valid insurance certificate and proof the vehicle is currently taxed.**

**Competitors in Division B and C as well as D2 and D3 must produce their Vehicle Competition Passport.**

There will be a noise test during the event.

As a competitor it is your responsibility to ensure your car complies with all current technical & safety regulations. If you have any questions prior to the event please contact the Event Scutineer, Robin Wallace [robinwallace@btinternet.com](mailto:robinwallace@btinternet.com) or 07885 691816

12. Competitors should walk the course before the drivers' briefing as some of the track margins have changed since the resurfacing.

13. Competitors are reminded that there is a **5mph SPEED LIMIT IN ALL THE PADDOCK AREAS**. Offenders may be excluded from the event.

14. Tyre Warming is **NOT PERMITTED**. The deliberate spinning of vehicle wheels in public areas, including the paddock, is strictly forbidden and anyone doing so may be disqualified from the event. Single use protective tyre wrap is **NO LONGER ALLOWED AT KAMES MOTORSPORT COMPLEX**.

15. Competitors are requested to take a sensible approach if they inadvertently leave the track. **DO NOT SPIN TYRES BUT AWAIT ASSISTANCE IF REQUIRED**. Competitors who consistently cut corners will be penalised.

16. Results will be streamed by ScotResults throughout the weekend.

Results will be on [scotresults.org](http://scotresults.org). There will be buttons on the left side of the page for Saturday and for Sunday. During the day they will show interim results. At the end of the day we will also post provisional results, final results, and awards on the Virtual Notice Board.

17. The following Awards will be presented as soon as possible after the Results are declared Final:

- Fastest Combined Time of Day, Saturday and Sunday - Bo'ness Trophy and replica  
(**note:** the Bo'ness Trophy remains the property of the Scottish Sporting Car Club and may be held for 10 months, following which it must be returned to the Club at the expense of the holder).
- Fastest Time of Day, Saturday – perpetual award
- Fastest Time of Day, Sunday – perpetual award
- Class Awards on both days will be notified by means of a notice on the virtual notice board
